The Veterans Outreach Program Unique Opportunity to Support Local Veterans A Challenge to All SAR Members

Background

At the Cincinnati Chapter's April Meeting, we learned that Compatriot Douglas Carver recently established a Scholarship Fund for student veterans at the University of Cincinnati's Blue Ash College.

According to Andrew Baker, Director of Development at UC Blue Ash, the college's regional campus has over 5,000 students, approximately 4% of which identify themselves as US Veterans. Typical the GI Bill covers only 25-50% of their college expenses depending on the situation. Mr. Baker assisted Compatriot Carver in setting up the Veterans Scholarship Fund to bridge the gap between those funds provided by the GI Bill and the true cost of education.

Commitment

Initially, subject to fund availability, the scholarship fund plans to award scholarships to up to three (3) students annually, in an amount of up to \$500 per student per year.

Who Can Qualify

Applicants must be considered Veterans of the United States Armed Forces, and preference will be given to students who were deployed overseas during their service.

What Does the Scholarship Cover

The scholarships can be used to help cover practically any kind of expenses associated with veterans obtaining their education (guidelines to be firmed up in time).

Future Expansion of the Program

It is hoped that with additional donations, the fund can be converted to an endowment fund, which will provide steady annual funding for veteran scholarships in perpetuity.

Why

This is an excellent opportunity to support a compatriot's initiative and to support local veterans.
